The Eastern Missouri Pavement Consortium is a cooperative effort of public works organizations in the St. Louis Metro Area. The EMPC goal is to propose standardized material specifications for durable concrete on public works projects to members and to simplify the approval process with the assistance of the web site:

The EMPC was modeled after regional specifications with the goals of:

- Improved quality and durability of concrete projects
- Reduced life-cycle costs.
- Faster, easier concrete approval process.
- Consistency in requirements.
- Improved communications with concrete suppliers, agencies, trade organizations.

EMPC MEMBER BENEFITS:

- Concrete mix designs reviewed and approved by experienced engineers.
- Standardized requirements across member agencies.
- Material testing for quality control.
- Annual approval of concrete mixes rather than project by project.
- Concrete training courses for member agency staff.
- Website provides 24 hour access to specification, mix approvals and approved material suppliers.
- Specification updated annually.
- Information and presentations from members of academia including the Iowa State National Concrete Pavement Technology Center.
- Material testing and administrative costs split between agencies based on population.
- Nominal fees charged to suppliers and producers reduce agency costs.
